Getting Started

This manual is intended for use with CST2000 series trackballs.

Compatibility:

Windows 98SE and later, including Windows XP and Vista, MAC OS9.8 and later, and all operating systems that are USB 1.0 and HID 1.1 compliant such as Linux, Unix, IBM AIX and others.

Installing your trackball:

Simply plug the trackball into any available USB port on your computer. Drivers will load automatically. Wait a few moments and roll the ball to test the connection. Some systems may play a sound after successfully starting the device. We recommend you NOT plug the trackball into an external USB hub. Instead, find an open USB port on your system and plug in directly, this offers the best performance.

Selectable Resolution: Resolution switching is done by pressing and holding the center button and then clicking the right button. Each time this is done, the resolution (default on first power on = 800CPI) will toggle to the next resolution. At first plugin, it will be at 800CPI, perform the above action and it will switch to 1600CPI, do it again and it will go to 400CPI, repeat and it will go back to 800 and so on. It is not necessary to release the center button if you want to advance by two settings, in other words, you may press and hold the center button and click the right button until you reach the desired resolution and then release the center button.

Installing Superior-X Button Control:

To Install Superior-X button Control, you may select "Install Superior-X: on the L-Trac index page, or you may locate the "Setup" file in the Superior-X folder on the CD.

If the trackball is not rolling smoothly please read the Cleaning The Trackball guide before calling support. For questions about trackballs contact the reseller that you purchased from. You should have the trackball with you to insure you have all information needed to help correctly identify any problems.
